

Frequently Asked Questions About the Student Portal

Q: What is the Student Portal?

A: The Student Portal is a window in the Texas Assessment website that allows parents and students to view individual student results from the Texas state assessments.

Q: How do I log in to the Student Portal?

A: The login link for the Student Portal is located at <http://www.TexasAssessment.com/Students>. From there, you will be able to click on a link that will take you to the Student Portal Login page. Enter the Unique Access Code and your student's date of birth as provided on the student's most recent Confidential Student Report and you will gain access to the assessment data in the Student Portal.
