I. Purchases:

- A. Uniform - \$120
- B. Shoes - \$60
- C. Bag - \$25
- D. Jacket - \$45
- E. Props - \$30
- F. Shirts - \$25
- G. Accessories Case - \$15
- H. Tights - \$20
- I. Misc - \$10

Deposit (\$150) – DUE DAY OF TRYOUTS – 4/23/2022

Remaining (\$200) – DUE DAY OF FIRST OFFICIAL PRACTICE – 6/11/2022

Returning Majorettes will not be required to purchase a new uniform or jacket if it is still up to field standards. I.E. (No tears, rips, stains, Etc.). If you choose to use a previous Uniform/Jacket, you will still be responsible for providing your deposit the day of try outs.

Fundraiser/donation forms will be sent with each participant to take home the day of try outs.

II. Expectations:

A. Attend every practice and performance. If candidates have conflicts, let me know as soon as possible and we will work out a solution to catch up on missed choreography.

B. Arrive on time. This means ready to go at the start of practice. Please be prompt and courteous to your teammates.

C. Maintain a positive attitude.

D. Give 100% at all times.

E. Pass all classes. No Pass, No Participation.

F. **Respect the coaches and directors.** What they say goes. They are here to help and guide you.

G. **Obey rehearsal procedures.**

1. Have a baton and props at each practice.
2. Have appropriate clothing and shoes. Candidates will not be allowed to participate in jeans, flip flops or be barefoot/socks only.

III. Uniforms:

A. Candidates are responsible for maintenance of uniforms.

1. Wash on cold separately and hang dry.
2. Make sure shoes are clean before each performance.

B. Majorettes are responsible for all items purchased. Please keep items together to ensure preparedness each week.

C. Appearance is part of the uniform.

1. Candidates will be required to have their hair neat. Hair must be **AT LEAST HALF WAY UP, AND NO BANGS IN THE FACE.**
2. Red lipstick will be provided to each participant. This is required for each **FIELD** performance. Candidates do not have to wear during the Pep Rally performance.

D. Undergarments shall not show under uniforms.

E. Candidates may wear "*Theme of the Week*" accessories with uniforms during **school only**. They must be removed for **FIELD** performances.

F. Candidates may wear small stud earrings while in uniform. No watches, rings or large earrings.

G. Black tights are required to be worn during school while in uniform. Candidates will remove before **FIELD** performances. Skin colored tights are allowed for game performances if desired.

H. Uniforms will be fitted the day of try outs. Please have a parent available to approve the sizing of the uniform before it is ordered.

IV. Practices:

A. Attendance at all practices is **MANDATORY** to maintain a spot and eligibility to perform. Conflicts with other school activities will be worked out in advance.

B. BE ON TIME!

C. The BAND App will be utilized during the season so communication can be sent out regarding any changes to the schedule.

V. Games:

A. We will meet at a predetermined time at the Band Hall and walk to the field together.

B. MAJORETTES SIT TOGETHER IN THE STANDS. THERE WILL BE NO WALKING AROUND AND HANGING OUT WITH FRIENDS. Majorettes are there to support the other athletes and should focus on the game. If parents need to speak with you they are welcome to come to our area.

C. Majorettes will go to the concession stand together after the first performance. This will be the only trip, so please bring water if needed.

D. Majorettes do not go to out of town games. Only **HOME** games.

E. Majorettes are free to go after the SECOND field performance. Please have a plan on how to get home.

VI. Social Media:

A.
